Moore Stephens Tiller Walks for Autism

According to Autism Speaks, 1 in 150 individuals are diagnosed with autism, making it more common than pediatric cancer, diabetes and AIDS combined. A recent article from the Harvard School of Public Health reports that the cost of caring for an autistic person over his or her lifetime can be as high as \$3.5 million.

MST became aware of this worthy event because The Marcus Institute was a primary supporter.

“The Marcus Institute is a well-known, non-profit organization that is passionate about providing aid for autistic children and young adults,” says Greg Hayes, partner in charge of MST’s Gwinnett office. “We’ve had a long-standing professional relationship with the Institute, and we look for ways to support the Institute and the cause whenever possible.”

The MST Gwinnett office put together a team to organize its participation in the walk. “We had team t-shirts printed and spread the word. Everyone who took part in the event really seemed to enjoy it.”
